

# Objective behind assessment

- Give the teacher an exact idea of the learners proficiency level and progress
- Make learners more confident
- Develop an affinity for the language
- Activate certain mental faculties and sub skills.
- Assess comprehension rather than memory
- Improve language step by step through a skill building process




